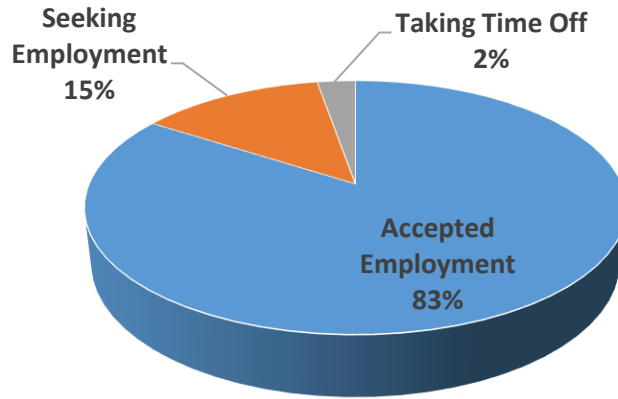

MASTER OF ACCOUNTANCY (MAcc) OUTCOMES

The Collins College of Business MAcc prepares graduates to apply discipline-specific knowledge and skills to provide the foundation for a successful career in accounting. The program allows students to develop critical thinking skills, as well as foster an understanding of the strategic role of accounting in business organizations and society. TU MAcc graduates had an employment placement rate of 75%.

The part time option is for working professionals and is designed to help sharpen business skills and enhance career advancement opportunities. TU MBA graduates had an employment placement rate of 88%.
